<p>Kinderdance® is an age appropriate developmental dance, motor skills, movement and fitness program. This program is an optional class that includes an extra fee.</p> <p>Kindertots (Toddler) - A 30-minute program designed to develop gross motor skills, movement creativity, physical development (flexibility, strength, balance, coordination), tumbling, body awareness and communication skills, while learning numbers, colors, shapes, and songs. A fee of \$40 per month is paid directly to Kinderdance of Michigan.</p> <p>KinderDance (Preschool+) – A 45-minute developmental dance, motor skills, movement and fitness program taught on 3 levels, teaching the basics of ballet, tap, acrobatics and creative movement while learning numbers, colors, shapes, words and songs. A fee of \$50 per month is paid directly to Kinderdance of Michigan.</p> <p>September – May Monday mornings. Performance in June.</p> <p>KinderYoga (Toddler - PreK) – A 30-minute program that inspires movement awareness in children through activities that energize, stretch, strengthen and relax their minds and bodies. Parents and teachers will love seeing boys and girls thrive with our child-friendly music, fun fitness, playful movements and imaginative activities. The cost for this program is included in the Summer Camp Fee.</p> <p>June – August Monday and Tuesday mornings</p> <p>www.kinderdanceofmichigan.com</p>	<p>Amazing Athletes is an age appropriate program designed to teach your child the fundamentals and mechanics of 9 different sports while mastering 7 key areas of motor development. This program is an optional class that includes an extra fee.</p> <p>Amazing Tots (Toddler) – A 35-minute, weekly class that encompasses one sports lesson along with a balanced combination of structured physical challenges and organized discover-based sports lessons. Fitness activities include color recognition, shape classification, letter identification, and action vocabulary. A fee of \$88 per 8-week session is paid directly to Amazing Athletes of Metro Detroit.</p> <p>Amazing Athletes (Preschool+) – A 35-minute, weekly class where children learn the importance of patience, teamwork, and self-confidence in a non-competitive, learning-based environment that fosters a love of healthy living. These fun, active classes encourage kids to explore and develop a variety of athletic skills through the introduction of 9 different sports. Coaches break the fundamentals of each sport-based skill down into simple steps based on each child's age and ability.
